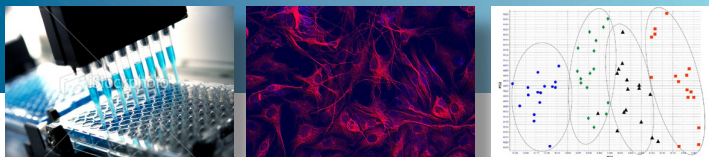

- > Representing its members in committees and stakeholder meetings dedicated to the advancement of *in vitro* testing

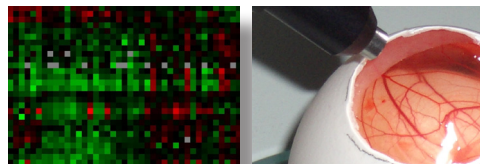
## ESTIV CONGRESS

Every two years ESTIV members meet in a unique atmosphere for discussions and exchange of knowledge during the ESTIV congress (formerly INVITOX workshop) organised by the Society. The congress promotes contacts between junior and senior researchers involved in the development and use of *in vitro* methods in toxicology and toxicity testing.

Invited speakers and presentations selected from submitted abstracts highlight important recent research contributions, new topics and advances in *in vitro* science and its application. Young *in vitro* toxicologists are encouraged by the Young Scientist Award for the best oral presentation and for the best poster presentation. Time is made available for interactive discussions.

Exchange of information is further stimulated by organising intermediate workshops with either demonstrations or discussions in working groups. ESTIV also organise joint events together with national societies and/or sister organisations to further increase visibility and recognition of *in vitro* toxicology.
