Greet Schoeters is Emeritus Professor at the University of Antwerp and vice president of the Belgian Superior Health Council since 2022. She has managed projects in environmental health and environmental toxicology at VITO (Flemish Institute for Technological research) for more than 30 years. She coordinated the Flemish human biomonitoring project between 2002 and 2020. She has helped to build EU wide human biomonitoring activities through active involvement in the EU projects ESBIO, COPHES, DEMOCOPHES and HBM4EU. She served as vice chair of the Scientific Advisory Committee of the European Environment Agency (2012-2020), participated in different risk assessment committees (EFSA, SCHER) and was president of the European Society for Toxicology in Vitro (2008-2012). Special interest are the use and implementation of molecular biomarkers in cohort studies, in vitro mechanistic toxicology to better understand the effects of chemicals in humans and to improve the dialogue with decision makers and stakeholders to promote the uptake and use of the scientific results.
